The program officially begins on **Tuesday**, **May 27**, **which is the day after Memorial Day** and end on Friday, August 1. <u>Move in will be Saturday/Sunday prior</u>. Since Monday is a holiday, things on campus will be closed, so please plan to arrive on Saturday or Sunday. Move out will be either Friday August 1 or Saturday August 2. <u>Once you have made travel</u> <u>plans</u>, <u>please let me know the details of when you plan to arrive</u>. If you wish to fly to Rochester, the airport code is ROC, it's only a few miles away from campus. There is also a train station served by Amtrak, a bus station, and various bus services operating from NYC and other cities. Regardless of where you arrive, we can arrange a pickup from there and drop-off on campus (and a drop-off back on the final day too).

We provide all students with a \$500 travel allowance to cover travel costs. If you anticipate that your costs will be larger, please contact myself and Wenli Chen, cc'd here, and we can work to defray all of your travel costs. If purchasing a ticket may present a financial hardship, contact us about that too, we can likely help in that case as well.

On-campus housing will be provided in a campus apartment. These are suites of four with individual bedrooms and shared common areas. The apartments are fully furnished and include bedding and towels, but you will need to bring your own kitchen supplies. We have some basic kitchen supplies on hand from last year (plates, silverware, glasses, some pots and pans) that you are all welcome to use.
